

## A Unique Opportunity: Study and Travel to Accra, Ghana West Africa during the 2016 Presidential Election\*

The African Democracy Project (ADP) combines study abroad opportunities and intensive seminar courses focusing on citizenship, government systems and language to explore emerging democracies through a global lens.

The next ADP offering, African Democracy Project: Ghana is scheduled for Fall 2016. A trip to Ghana during

the country's presidential elections will be a highlight of the course.



President Emeritus/Distinguished Professor Irvin D. Reid and Assistant Professor of History Jennifer Hart invite you to join this unique foreign opportunity in Ghana, West Africa. First, you will study Ghanaian democracy here at Wayne State University. Then you will travel with Drs. Reid and Hart on a 12-day field study to Ghana in October/November 2016 to observe the national elections including the presidential election. Students will interact with government officials, students, and ordinary citizens. You will also have an opportunity to share your experience on a documentary.

This course covers history and politics in Ghana through themes like urban culture, grassroots development, informal economies, digital technology and internet/new media culture, nationalism, popular culture, and pan-Africanism. Students are encouraged to pursue their own research interests by building on these course themes and conducting their own additional reading and research.

You will mostly be based in Accra, the capital, and will have the opportunity to take day trips to some nearby regions.

Enrollment (permission only) will be limited to 12 students and will cost approximately \$3500 plus tuition and personal expenses per student.
